What time period does the information in this Annual Report cover?


All of the Town's financial information in this report (expenses, revenues and employee compensation information) is for the <u>2020-2021 Fiscal Year (FY21)</u> beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021. We are required to report audited financials for the Annual Town Report and FY21 is the most recent fiscal year for which we have audited figures. The current fiscal year that we are in (FY21) does not end until June 30, 2022.

However, because of the timing when we print the Annual Town Report nearly a year after the Town's last fiscal year ends, Department Head reports and other letters offer information based on different timeframes such as calendar year 2022 and more recent information when applicable.

The primary reason for different time periods is that the most current data for various areas of the Town operation: audited financials, tax assessments, crime statistics, building permits, etc., varies depending on the data source. In all cases, we strive to give you the fullest and most up-to-date information about Town operations. We have noted on each data table the specific time period for which the figures are related.

Dear Sabattus Community Members,

Please first allow me to reintroduce myself, as I have only been with you and the Town of Sabattus for less than a year now. For those of you that I have not met, as of yet, my name is Timothy Kane. I was hired as your Town Manager and began my duties on September 13, 2021. I've had a wonderful time working for the Town of Sabattus over the last 8 months. As you are all aware, the Town's quality of life and sense of place is dictated on the love, appreciation, and generosity from its citizens.

As I began my duties, my first order of business was to review and align each of our departments. We were down in staffing and in need of filling some critical positions. My main goal was to fill these positions with qualified personnel. We have taken the first step and hired a very qualified Police Chief. I have also taken over the position of Public Works Director. As I am also the Road Commissioner, this makes sense to help with cost savings for the Town. A review of our budget, budget process, and creating this budget was next.

In today's continually changing environment, with rising gas prices and out of control costs, we knew this would be challenging. Always wanting to remain fiscally responsible to our Sabattus Community, we have developed this budget, keeping everyone in mind. The goal of our annual report is to update and keep our residents informed of the financial environment.

As Town Meeting is nearly here, please take the time to fully consider the pros and cons of the Town Warrant articles – whether your vote is a sentimental vote from the heart or whether it is a logical vote from your head, it is important to be involved in the decision-making process of your Town. There are a few tough decisions that will need to be made this year.

Several individual departmental budgets will be up this year. This is to cover the costs of supplies and materials needed to serve our Town. Also, competing with other Town's and governmental organizations in the race to recruit and retain quality personnel is now the norm around the state and country. With that all being said, our Selectboard, working with our Budget Committee have made the decisions to utilize money from our Undesignated Fund account. By doing this, we will not see an increase in taxes, from the municipal side. We will also be paying off, early, several outstanding capital expenses, thus helping to reduce future budgets.

Finally, if you feel the need to get out of the house, please consider joining a committee or becoming a volunteer in some manner. Without volunteers, and those willing to work on projects and committees, projects would not get done. Your efforts as a volunteer do not go unnoticed!! Volunteers and community involvement impact your town, your friends, family and neighbors. Be a volunteer!

To the Citizens of Sabattus,

The Police Department has seen a drastic change over the past fiscal year. In July of 2021 the Police Department had a total of seven sworn officers. As of April of 2022, we are at three. Several officers left law enforcement all together and three went to other agencies. The entire leadership team was nonexistent since early February. Town Manager Dr. Timothy Kane put out an advertisement for a Police Chief position and on March 1st, 2022, I was sworn in as the Chief.

My name is Erik Baker and I retired from the Maine State Police as a Lieutenant after serving since November of 1995. I had previous experience working with Sagadahoc SO in 1989. In 1993 I went to work with Brunswick Police Department until being hired with the State Police. I have a bachelor's degree from Elmira College in New York and attended the FBI National Academy, class 263, in January of 2016.

My wife and I reside in the town of Brunswick, and we have two adult children. My daughter just graduated with her master's degree in public health and my son is currently a Junior at college in Connecticut.

I have been asked why I chose the Town of Sabattus. I chose to apply here because I knew the citizens of the town were very supportive of the Police Department. Over the past several years policing in America has changed in how they view the police, but the Town of Sabattus still gives the police department opportunities to be part of the community. I believe in a community that believes in us! This community makes us feel welcomed into their homes and businesses. The Sabattus Police Department wants to earn your trust and friendship by community policing.

I have high expectations of myself, and the men and women of the police department. I am a big believer that the Chief needs to be out in the public listening and talking to the citizens. If I do not get out in the public and have conversations, then how will I know what the problems are and how would I be able to fix them.

The police department has worked with the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) to come up with a good contract to entice people to come to work here. We have posted advertisements in multiple social media outlets, attended career fairs at local colleges, and tried to sell our department by word of mouth. The hope is to attract some senior police officers to the agency. We currently have four openings and will keep the applications open until they are filled. One thing I will not do is drop our standards when hiring to just fill the vacancies. It may take us a little longer to fill the vacancies, but we want quality people.

I have set the standard that an applicant will take an oral board, a polygraph, an extensive background, a psychological examination, and then a final interview with myself and the Town Manager. If the person has not attended the full-time academy, they will be required to pass the physical fitness standards set by the academy. An officer will be on probation one year after they graduate from the academy. If we hire an officer who has graduated the academy, then they will be on probation for six months. We will also require an officer to be assigned to a Field Training Officer (FTO) for a period.

You will see a new look in the appearance of the officers. We have gone to a black uniform with a red stripe. The patches on the side of our uniform are the original patches. We believe the police department should represent the community and we will be doing this with a professional appearance. We believe when you look professional, you will act professional, and the public will treat you professional.

We have hired Officer Magan Brown, who is a resident of town. She will be working as the school resource officer in the fall. Magan brings ten years of law enforcement experience to the department having worked for Lewiston Police Department. Her knowledge of the town and the citizens will be a great help as we move forward rebuilding the department.

Officer Richard Stanton has stuck through all the changes within the department. He has prior experience with Lewiston Police Department. He will be leading the firearms program as we get back on track.

The town is fortunate to have Missy Kelly as our executive assistant. Anyone that comes into our lobby will be met by Missy. She always has a smile on her face loves to help the public. Missy has been employed with us for over twenty years!

One of the most significant things we are trying to bring about is updating the technology. We are currently having Maine Crash Reporting being updated in the computers. This will allow the officer to print off the driver's information at the scene of a crash and share it with each party. The driver's then can report the information to their insurance companies.

Officers will be using e-citation after the second week of May. E-citation allows officers to write infraction tickets on the computer. Once the ticket is written it is automatically sent via the cloud to the violation's bureau. This way tickets are not being lost in the mail or not sent in a timely manner. The violator would be given two computer printed copies of the violation and an envelope to either pay the violation or dispute the violation.

We will be training with other agencies to bring consistency when backing each other up. You may see Lisbon Police Department and Androscoggin Sheriff's Department in the area at times. By having this relationship, it will keep officers safe, and we will know each other's capabilities when responding to incidents. I would like to give a thank you to the Androscoggin Sheriff's Department for assisting the Town of Sabattus with the night coverage as we rebuild our Police Department.

We have been a very proactive department in the last several months within the community. We participated in the community resource fair held at the middle school, national drug take back was done on April 30th at the Police Department. Officer Brown has been getting into all the schools working with the kids. We have also been working with Tri-County mental health. We team up with a member and introduce them to people fighting substance abuse. The member will work with that person to get the services they need to break the cycle.

As the Chief of Police, I want to let the citizens of Sabattus know we appreciate all the support we have received. We promise you our officers are excited to serve you and will be there when you call upon us.

Annual Town Report

Dear Citizens of Sabattus;

Let me first start off by thanking everyone for their continued support over the last year. The department and the community made my second year as fire chief exciting and extremely rewarding. The past two years in the world have been challenging, however I believe we all have made the most of it and are starting to get back to our normal lives.

Apparatus;

We have been very fortunate to have the support from our town and from the select board to be able to keep expanding and improving our fleet of vehicles. The new Engine-6 has been in service for over a year now and has served us extremely well. It has responded to 40% of our calls over the last year. This is the vehicle that you will see during the daytime hours at any type of fire or medical emergency in the town or surrounding communities. This piece of apparatus is staffed by the 2 per-diem FF's. We have been able to utilize numerous pieces of the new equipment that came with the vehicle on various calls throughout the community.

The next new piece of apparatus we have been fortunate to get is an EMS response vehicle. This vehicle is a 2014 Ford Explorer that was purchased at Sabattus Auto on Middle Road. This vehicle was purchased and completely upfitted utilizing APRA Funding that the town had received due to the pandemic. This vehicle is what our members use in the overnight hours to respond to EMS calls while the per-diem staffing is no longer on duty. Additionally; this vehicle will respond to second medical calls in town during the daytime hour. Lastly; this vehicle will also serve as a secondary command vehicle for large scale fire emergencies in the community or surrounding communities.

Our forestry truck was given a little bit of a facelift last year. For anyone that has seen it recently you may have noticed it now has all new LED emergency lights and scene lights 360 degrees around the vehicle. This has helped make the vehicle more visible during the daytime hours, assist crews with scene lighting at night and drastically reduced the power draw on the vehicle's batteries due to all the lights being LED now.

Car-1, Engine-2 and Tank-4 have all remained the same as the previous year, just have new decals to match the other vehicles in our fleet.

Membership;

Over the last year our membership has continued to shine, we have obtained some new members for our call company and for the per-diem roster. On January 1st the Town's Select board and Town Manager approved the fire department to begin staffing 2 per-diems on the weekends in addition to our Monday-Friday coverage. This has been an additional 32-hours a week that are now being covered with 2 FF/EMS providers. Additionally; we have been able to institute a "on-call" night position 7-nights a week. This person is responsible to respond to all fire and medical calls during the overnight hours while the per-diem staff is no

ger at the station. This person takes the EMS vehicle home and is able to respond directly from their dence to the emergency call.

we move forward our organization continues to grow and so does our call volume. We have moved from a strictly volunteer fire department to a part-time Fire/EMS organization in only a few short years.

Grants:

The Sabattus Fire Department has been very fortunate over the last two years to have received a few grants from various organizations for the purchase of new and updated equipment. Our organization has received funding for a cardiac monitor, a LUCAS CPR device, new portable radios, wildland chain saws and many more vital pieces of equipment. Over the last two years we have successfully obtained over \$105,000 dollars in funding from local and national foundations. We continue to write grants monthly hoping to gain as much outside funding as possible to limit the financial burden on our citizens.

Calls for Service:

Last year the Sabattus Fire Department received 579 calls for service. This amount of calls equaled out to about 1.5 calls per day, this amount of calls is extremely taxing on our volunteer membership and is mainly handled by the per-diem staffing during the daytime hours. Out of these calls we had a few very major incidents that I believe displayed a high level of professionalism and dedication from our organization. Without the dedication and highly trained aspect of our membership these calls could have had a much worse outcome. I am proud of the work we did all year long on these calls for service.

Training:

With the current pandemic and COVID being such a hot topic STILL, a lot of our outside training opportunities were cancelled. However, we still were able to log some very good and in-depth training hours for our members in-house and with outside vendors. The Sabattus Fire Department had a total of 2,365 combined hours of Fire/EMS training for the calendar year of 2021 between all of our members. That is something to be proud of!!

Recap;

As we continue in the year of 2022 we have started the year off fast with a lot of good trainings and a busy time for calls. We continue to push each day to make sure we are the most prepared to answer the call in your time of need. On behalf of myself and the entire Sabattus Fire Department we want to thank you for all you do for us and for the community. We hope you have a safe, happy and healthy year!





The Code Enforcement Officer, Building Inspector and Plumbing Inspector administers law relating to land use such as; building codes, shoreland zoning, minimum lot standards and the Maine Plumbing rules.


A major function of the Code Enforcement Office is to provide information to the public and to assist property owners in making prudent land use decisions. The office receives many requests for information on subjects ranging from land use regulations and building matters to issues involving State and Federal laws.

The office has an extensive collection of reference materials and can provide answers to some fairly complicated questions.

All construction within the boundaries of the Town of Sabattus requires a permit(s). Applicants may contact the Code Enforcement Officer at 751-6778 for any questions they may have. The Code Enforcement Office may also be contacted on the Internet at www.sabattus.org.

A permit is <u>required</u> for all new construction / remodeling / demolition / signage A permit is <u>not</u> required for repairs
A permit is <u>not</u> required for a boundary fence (max. 6' height)

Dear Sabattus Community Members,

As I am presently the acting Public Works Director and Road Commissioner, I would like to introduce where we are with the Public Works Department. We presently have an Assistant Director and 4 crew members. As the acting Director, we are also able to save, considerably, budget costs for the Town. Working closely with the Public Works crew, I have developed their budget to coincide with our seasonal work responsibilities.

Many of our main goals this year are to continue with ditching work, replacing culverts and repairing roads that have incurred damage from the winter. Unfortunately, due to the skyrocketing costs of items, such as fuel and tar, we will not be able to repair and repave the roads that we had originally planned for this fiscal year. Utilizing our Undesignated Funds, we will be able to pay off several capital projects, such as the municipal building, the fuel depot, 2020 dump truck, and transfer station containers. By doing this, it will alleviate money from our next budget. Thus, allowing us to focus on rebuilding our roads. Our Road Crew will continue to maintain our roads the best we can, utilizing our present equipment. We will continue to utilize the hot box for paving and replacing any areas that we will dig up.

Throughout the summer we will continue our road maintenance and ditching, which will assist with proper water runoff. We are constantly working on tree and brush removal as the growing season is now in full swing.

It is always our intention to provide the best possible level of service for our community. Our staff works very hard to provide this service for the community and is always ready for whatever comes up.

Transfer Station

To the Citizens of Sabattus,

Recycling tonnage rate was 30% for 2021 (the most current available) which 20% below the State of Maine's recycling goal. With the help of citizens, we can improve our recycling rate, increase our revenue and decrease our household waste as well as reduce the tipping fee charged to the town to dispose of:

By taking recycles out of the waste stream, citizens saved \$10,531.00 in tipping fees and collected \$42,834.00 from the sale of recycled material, demo wood, electronics and metal fees. We put a roof over the TV/Computer trailer and started re-siding our building. As we are doing the work, it is saving the tax payers \$7,000.00 in labor cost. Jamie, from Affordable Welling saved the tax payers \$6,000.00 by grinding brush.

Reminder, clear trash bags are required and available to purchase at the Transfer Station.

Sabattus Sanitary District & Water Division

ANNUAL REPORT 2022

The Sabattus Sanitary District's mission is to continue to serve it's customers in a professional manner and strive to achieve quality effluent through its wastewater treatment process and to protect the environment by meeting its discharge permit to the Sabattus River. The Department of Environmental Protection sets strict limits to achieve through our discharge permit and we take pride in meeting those limits on a continual basis. The District continues to go above and beyond to adapt and establish good working relationships with its customers and the people they work with to achieve the goals they set forth in the most cost effective manner, without affecting the quality of its work and product. Clean and safe drinking water is also a priority for the District as well as providing fire protection to its customers and residents of the community. Since its establishment in 1969, the drinking water in Sabattus meets all of the standards set forth by the State and Federal agencies and its guidelines. The District provides an excellent quality of water provided through 2 gravel packed wells located off of Riley Rd. and Marsh Rd. approximately 60 feet deep and pulls water from an underground aquifer. The District does not add any chemicals to its water supply. The District collects required monthly samples and performs testing to assure safe and great tasting quality water to its customers.

The Sabattus Sanitary District received 2 new residential sewer hook ups in 2021, and the water received 1 new service. In 2021, the Water Division encountered 2 water main breaks, one located on Hillside Drive in Oak Hill Park which was a 3-inch water main and the other was a big 6-inch water main at the intersection of rte. 126/132.

The total water pumped from Marsh Rd. pump house for 2021 was 53.63 million gallons, with a daily average of 151,000 gallons per day. All required sampling set by the State were met. The Water Division did encounter one coliform bacteria violation and the system was disinfected with chlorination and flushed. All protocol was followed to assure safe drinking water to our customers.

The Water Division collected samples at both wells for PFAS chemicals. The State set a limit of 20 parts per trillion and both wells had results at the lowest detectable limit of less than 2 parts per trillion.

The Water Division will be filing a water rate increase for 2022-2023 with the PUC to meet its financial obligations and budget. The District is doing this in a two-year process for a lesser burden on the ratepayers.

The Sewer Division treated approximately 31.75 million gallons, with a daily average of 97,000 gallons per day discharged into the Sabattus River. No violations occurred in 2021. Again, all testing required by the State met their requirements.

The District is always working and updating its Capital Improvement Plan (C.I.P.) for both departments. The District currently budgets these capital expenses and reserve accounts in its annual budget.

The District has been working with the Town to attain some of the (ARPA) American Rescue Plan Act money that was awarded to the Town to do some infrastructure improvements such as security cameras, new radio communications for the water systems pumping system, etc. This is Federal money that will not have to be paid back as used as grant money.

The District continues to contract with the Town to do all of its administrative duties in an order to save money and keep rates stable. All Payments will be made at the Town Office. We continue to communicate with the Town Manager and his staff on upcoming projects, safety issues etc... that benefit not only the employees but the ratepayers. The District is always looking for ways to provide its customers with the best quality product and do it in a cost effective manner.

The District is still working with Olver Associates from Winterport Maine to asses which option to choose in regards to upgrading the plant or doing an interconnection to Lewiston. We been in discussions with the City of Lewiston to look into an interconnection to the sewer system with Lewiston. We are gathering data to see which will be the most economical for the long-term Lewiston has attained an outside engineer to see what the cost associated in connecting would be as well as all other related fees and charges to handle our daily flows. DEP over the years has increased its requirements on what we can discharge into the Sabattus River. The latest mandate is Nutrient removal such as phosphorus removal. This is very expensive to treat via chemical addition as well as potential added filtration. The last upgrade was completed in 1989, 33 years ago. The process for funding, planning, etc. is typically a 2-3 year process. The District will be evaluating all information and will be holding public hearings at some point to gather any public comments and input.

ASSESSORS' AGENT & TAX COLLECTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT

The Town of Sabattus maintains permanent records with title information, descriptions of land and buildings, and the valuation of all properties taxable and exempt, tax maps, lists of property, property tax cards, commitment books, exemption applications and proof of qualifications.

Property Tax Exemptions The Town is now at 99% market value for 4/1/22

Homestead Exemption

Under this law, homeowners are eligible for a \$24,750 for Tax Year 2023. In order to qualify you must have owned property in Maine for at least twelve months prior to April 1st, 2021 and make the property you occupy your permanent residence.

Veteran's Exemption

A home owner may be eligible for a reduction in the valuation of his/her property if s/he:

- Has permanent residence in Sabattus on April 1st
- Is a veteran who was honorably discharged.
- Served during a recognized war period in the U.S. Armed Forces
- Is 62 or older or an un-remarried widow/widower of a qualifying veteran
- Is under age 62 but 100% disabled due to a service-related disability.

An application along with proof of service and discharge, such as a copy of a DD214 form must be provided for veterans who served during WWII or later. The exemption is a \$5,940 reduction in valuation.

Paraplegic Veteran

A veteran that received a federal grant for a specially-adapted housing unit may receive an exemption of \$49,500 in valuation.

Blind Exemption

A homeowner that is determined to be legally blind by a medical doctor receives a \$3,960 exemption.

All of the above exemptions require a completed application and may require additional information to support the claim for exemption. All applications must be submitted to the Town Office no later than April 1st of any given year.

Current Use Programs

The State of Maine offers the following "current use programs" which give the property owner a reduction in his/her assessed value. Applications for all these programs are available at the Town Office or at the Maine Revenue Services website (www.maine.gov). All applications must be filed on or before April 1st. In order to be eligible, each program has certain criteria that must be met. Any change in use of the land warrants withdrawal from the program and a penalty assessed.

Tree Growth

This program provides for the landowner with at least 10 acres of forested land that wishes to maintain land for the planting, culture, and continuous harvesting of trees. A Forest Management and Harvest Plan must be prepared and submitted with the application. Applications must include a map of the parcel indicating the forest type breakdown as well as all other areas not classified as tree growth. The 100% valuation per acre for each forest type by county is determined by the State Tax Assessor each year. If the classified parcel no longer meets the criteria of eligibility or the landowner withdraws from the program, a penalty on an amount between 20% and 30% of the difference between the tree growth value and the fair market value will be assessed depending on the amount of time in the program.

Farmland

In the farmland program, the land must be used for farming, agriculture, or horticulture. Farmland can include woodland and wasteland. At least five (5) contiguous acres of land is required and the tract must contribute at least \$2,000 gross income from farming activities per year in one of the two, or three of the five calendar years preceding the date of application. If the property no longer qualifies as farmland or the landowner withdraws from the program then a penalty will be assessed that is equal to: the amount of taxes that would have been paid in the last five years had it not been in the program, less the taxes that were originally assessed, plus any interest on that balance.

Open Space

Under this program no minimum acreage is required and the tract of land must be preserved or restricted in use to provide a public benefit such as public recreation, scenic resources, game management, or preserving wildlife habitat. Classified land is valued by reducing the fair market value in accordance with a cumulative percentage reduction for which the land is eligible according to certain categories.

- Ordinary Open Space 20% reduction
- Permanently Protected 30% reduction
- Forever Wild 20% reduction
- Public Access 25% reduction

If the property met all of the above requirements, the owner would see a cumulative reduction of up to 95% on the classified land. If the classified parcel no longer meets the criteria of eligibility or the landowner withdraws from the program, a penalty will be assessed equal to: an amount between 20% and 30% of the difference between the open space value and fair market value depending on the amount of time in the program.

Property Tax Fairness Credit

Eligible Maine taxpayers may receive a portion of the property tax or rent paid during the tax year on the Maine individual income tax return whether they owe Maine income tax or not.

Who is eligible for the Property Tax Fairness Credit? Homeowners or renters who meet all of the following requirements:

- 1. Were Maine residents during any part of the tax year;
- 2. Owned or rented a home in Maine during any part of the tax year and lived in that home during the year as a primary residence;
- 3. Paid property tax or rent on the primary residence in Maine during the tax year;
- 4. Meet certain income and property tax and/or rent paid limitations during the tax year.
- 5. Are not married filing separately.

How does someone apply for the refundable credit? To claim the credit, file Form 1040ME and Schedule PTFC or Schedule PTFC/STFC for the tax year during which the property tax or rent was paid.

** Important Notice about property taxes for buyers and sellers**

- 1. Under Maine law, payments of property taxes are the responsibility of the person who owns the property as of April 1st.
- 2. Both the buyer and seller may agree to divide the taxes between themselves, but if any part of the taxes are not paid, a lien will be filed in the name of the person who owned the property on April 1st.

Please be Aware

If you are the seller- Even if you no longer own the property, a lien may have a negative effect on your credit rating.

If you are the buyer- If a lien is filed in the sellers' name, The Municipality may still foreclose on your property for unpaid taxes.
